This description is for *Abutilon 'var album'* (*Abutilon vitifolium var album 'var album'*):

Abutilon vitifolium var album is a shrub native to Chile. The leaves are a grey green colour, lobed and toothed and covered in fine hairs. The saucer-shaped flowers are white with yellow anthers. It's not fully hardy so you'll need to protect it from frost, so it's a good idea to grow it in a container, then you can bring it indoors over winter. It likes full sun and light, well-drained soil. This species is best suited to the more experienced gardener, as it's not terribly easy to grow. It can also be grown as a house plant.
