*Allium narcissiflorum* Also known as: **Allium pedemontanum**

This description is for *allium* (*Allium narcissiflorum*):

A native of Portugal and Italy, allium narcissiflorum grows clusters of large bright pink or red bell shaped flowers, between four and ten on each plant. The leaves are flat and narrow. It likes a sunny spot and lime soil, also give it some shelter as it's quite a delicate plant. It's a non-invasive allium species. If you're growing these from seed they can take a long time to germinate. They don't need any extra heat, just a bit of patience. It grows fine in coastal areas.
