This description is for species *Alum root (Heuchera americana)*:

*Heuchera americana* is an herbaceous. Heart-shaped purplish leaves fade to green as they mature, and during summer, *H. americana* develops tall stems covered in soft white bell-shaped flowers. *H. americana* is best planted in full sun or partial shade and provided with well-drained soil that retains moisture. It's, therefore most suited to shady areas where drying out can be avoided. *H. americana* is particularly good in herbaceous borders, rock gardens and even containers, where it makes a good contrast plant and will offer colour all year round.
