Geranium asphodeloides is a bushy herbaceous perennial that's ideal for bringing colour to garden borders. *G. asphodeloides* develops pink and white flowers in the summer that contrast perfectly with the plant's bright green leaves. Also known as asphodel cranesbill, *G. asphodeloides* is best grown in a sunny spot with well-drained soil. It can tolerate partial shade, and will grow in most soil types as long as it isn't boggy. It's ideal for rockeries, borders and containers, and makes a perfect groundcover plant due to its spreading growth pattern.
