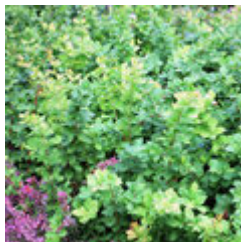
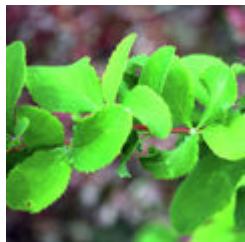


Barberry

Berberis koreana, commonly known as Korean barberry, is a deciduous shrub. It produces clusters of yellow flowers in the summer. Korean barberry prefers to grow in full sun or partial shade, and will thrive in most soil types, as long as the soil isn't waterlogged. One of the main attractions of *berberis koreana* is that in addition to the flowers, it produces bright scarlet berries in the autumn. At the same time the foliage turns from green to red. It has long thorns, which make it ideal for use as a boundary hedge, and give it a strong resistance against deer and rabbit damage.
