Barrenwort (*Epimedium x versicolor*):

A popular plant in Japan, *Epimedium x versicolor* or Barrenwort is an easy plant to grow in the UK as well. In general a very hardy plant that can cope with the extremes of the British weather as long as you plant in a shaded or semi-shaded location. The foliage is lovely, with bronzed or red veined leaves. In the spring time it blooms with pinky-apricot coloured flowers that are both stunning and delicate at the same time. A good choice for the novice or time short gardener.
