This shrub is both tough and beautiful, displaying glossy oval-shaped leaves that turn from dark green to purple in colder weather, with pretty white flowers in summer and lustrous rich red berries in autumn. This shrub takes the stress out of gardening as it can be planted in any well-drained soil within partial shade or full sunlight. The spreading tendency of bearberry cotoneaster makes this an excellent groundcover shrub or a stunning cascade of colour down a wall or slope. However it is used, this shrub will turn an unbearable gardening experience into something to really sink your teeth into.
