This description is for species **Bearberry cotoneaster** (*Cotoneaster x suecicus*):

Cotoneaster x suecicus, also called Coral Beauty, is a small evergreen plant. During May, C. x suecicus is covered in creamy white flowers, and these become bright orange berries in the autumn and winter months. In addition, large rounded green leaves provide interesting colour throughout the seasons. Coral beauty is best grown in a sunny spot that has well-drained soil. It can tolerate periods of dryness once it is established and, as such, makes a suitable drought tolerant plant. It needs very little maintenance, and is suitable for beginners.
