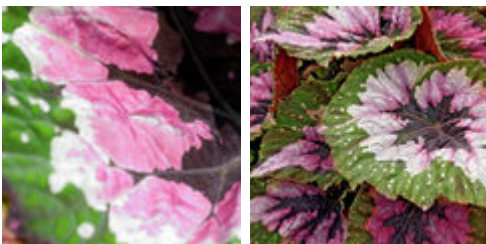


Begonia 'Merry Christmas'
