This description is for **Bellflower (Campanula piperi)**:

It takes hard work and dedication to create a top garden design but you can begin the training by introducing campanula piperi, which is commonly known as olympic bellflower to your outdoor space. The leaves of this plant are spoon-shaped and toothed, while the flowers resemble open bells and usually come in shades of blue, though white flowers exist as well. Growing this plant en masse in a rock garden will create a champion display. A sunny position within moderately fertile, moist and well-drained soil will make olympic bellflower a happy contender for the prettiest plant in your garden.
