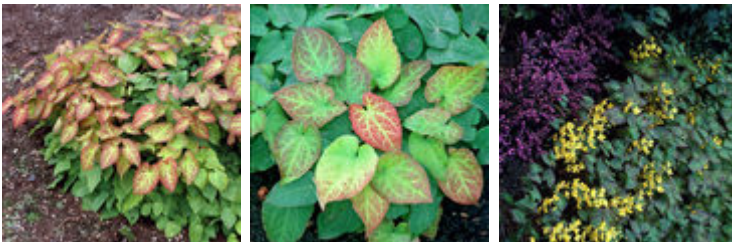


This description is for species *Bishop's Mitre (Epimedium x perralchicum)*:

A very hardy little number, although plant in a sheltered, partially shaded position for the very best results.
