This description is for species **Blanket flower** (*Gaillardia x grandiflora*):

Gaillardia x grandiflora is an herbaceous short-lived perennial that develops bright orange, red and yellow blooms that attract wildlife and provide immediate interest in any garden. Often called blanket flower, *G. x grandiflora* is best grown in full sun and provided with well-drained soil. It's tolerant to some drought, making it an ideal plant for hot borders in direct sunshine. During longer dry periods, it may need watering. Whilst winter hardy, in particularly cold areas, it can be used effectively as an annual.
