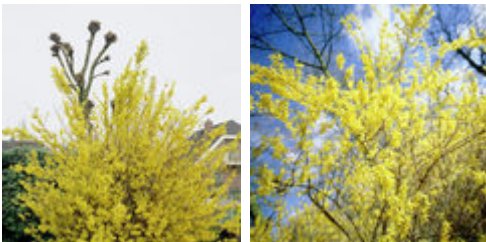


This description is for *Border Forsythia 'Lynwood'* (*Forsythia x intermedia* 'Lynwood') :

*Forsythia x intermedia* is a wonderful, tall growing shrub that sports arching branches. During the autumn its green leaves turn yellow or purple before shedding for the winter. However, its real crowning glory is its plethora of pale yellow flowers that literally cover the plant during the spring time. It's a great plant for the beginner or time short gardener, as it requires little skill to successfully cultivate and barely any on-going maintenance. Border Forsythia looks wonderful in virtually any situation, plus it has the advantage that you can take cuttings and place them in flower arrangements.
