Crystal anthurium

This description is for **Crystal anthurium** (*Anthurium crystallinum*):

The distinct white patterning on the leaves make this plant so vain.

Anthurium crystallinum is a plant native to South and Central America where it grows at the edges of rainforests. It will grow to just under a metre high and it'll grow bushy. It has big oval shape leaves, they're green with distinct white veins and a texture of velvet. It's been given an Award of Garden Merit by the RHS. It won't grow outdoors in cooler climates, but it does make a good house plant. It's low maintenance, doesn't require any pruning but can be affected by scale insects and leaf spot. Give it moist and well-drained sandy or loamy soil.
