This description is for **Golden Bunch** (*Crocus ancyrensis*):

## Cup-like flowers provide a drink of nectar to early insects

*Crocus ancyrensis* is a beautiful perennial flowering bulb. Beginning to flower in late winter, with blooms appearing through to early spring, *C. ancyrensis* produces bright golden flowers and is often called 'Golden Bunch' for this reason. *C. ancyrensis* should be grown in a position that receives full sun. The soil should be well-drained, poor quality and gritty to ensure that bulbs don't rot in wet winters. Golden Bunch is ideal for use in flowerbeds, but can sometimes be overwhelmed by other plants. For this reason, growing in pots can be very effective.
