Grey Club Rush

Schoenoplectus lacustris subsp. tabernaemontani

This description is for **Grey Club Rush** (*Schoenoplectus lacustris subsp. tabernaemontani*):

Dealing with any waterside areas of a garden can be tricky, but *schoenoplectus lacustris subsp. tabernaemontani* offers a tantalising solution. An evergreen perennial bog grass, its tall, dark to grey-green stems grow in dense clumps, adding great texture to any view over a water feature. Also known as the grey club rush, its colour is maintained year round, but it flowers in summer to produce tall panicles of tiny brown blossoms. Ideal for waterside plots, as well as groundcover over boggy areas, this low maintenance grass can also be planted in water. Left to prosper, it can spread vigorously.
