Hebe stenophylla is a bushy and evergreen shrub. In summer *h. stenophylla* develops flower spikes of dense white blooms that are extremely attractive to insects and butterflies. Long spear-shaped leaves provide extra interest to this garden specimen. *H. stenophylla* is best suited to a position that's in full sun or partial shade. It prefers moist soil that's well-drained if it's to thrive, and is often used in flowerbeds and wildlife areas. It's also tolerant to salt spray, making *h. stenophylla* an ideal plant for coastal gardens.
