Used to add texture and foliage to gardens, it also thrives in wet conditions, so is ideal if you have a boggy or damp area of the garden. This grass is easy to grow, requiring little on-going maintenance. This makes it a great addition to the garden of the novice or time short gardener. It's tough enough to cope with the worst of the British weather, asking only to be located in a sunny position to best thrive.
