Prunus persica or peach is a very common fruit bearing tree that produces delicious sweet and juicy edible fruit. A native of China and South Asia it will grow between four and ten metres in height. It has veined, lance shaped leaves and pink blossoms that bloom in early springtime. The fruits are a pinky orange colour, round in shape and have a furry skin. Peaches look similar to nectarines, but you can tell which is which as the nectarine has a smooth skin. Each fruit contains a large seed; peach stones or kernels are used as an abrasive element in many exfoliating beauty products. Peaches are used as an ingredient in a wide range of products from food and drink, to bath and household cleansing products. Peaches are the key flavour in the famous Bellini cocktail.
