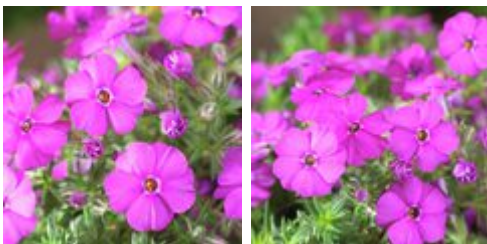
This description is for species *phlox* (*Phlox douglasii*):

Phlox is suited to areas of full sunlight or partial shade and appreciates fertile, well-drained soil such as chalky, loamy or sandy soil. This plant does well in a variety of garden designs, from cottage gardens to rock gardens. It can be used as stunning edging and can also be grown in containers and placed on patios or within courtyard gardens for a splash of sassy colour.
