This description is for **Stonecrop 'Herbstfreude'** (*Sedum 'Herbstfreude'*):

As a genus, Sedum has some 350 species to its name and with such an array of colours, textures and appearances, it can arguably create a garden all of its own. But, whether you'd prefer a contained, luxurious mound of greenery or larger areas carpeted by spreading foliage, Sedum is certain to have something to suit you. Known as Stonecrop, a common feature amongst most species is the clusters of tiny star-shaped yellow, pink, red or white flowers that rise above the foliage on branched stems. And since they are considered perfect for rockeries and border edges, many gardens have at least one species. Hardy in cold and drought, the right soil conditions depend on the species.
